I very recently got my 'Spacescape' comic published over at Ka-Blam. You may remember it, I used to post the panels here at HM.

I placed an order for it to check out the quality. Well enough, it looked pretty good. It cost me \$2.84 plus \$2.35 S & H (\$5.19 in all). So I ordered another one about a week or so later. Suddenly the print cost for the exact same product is now \$3.04 and the S & H has shot up to \$3.18 making the total \$6.22, over a dollar difference. Why the sudden hike?

I have notified them as to my concern, and awaiting reply. In the meantime, has anyone else ever dealt with Ka-Blam?
