I was fooling about with this inflation calculator and noticed something interesting. Goods that cost 10 cents in 1938 (like comics) would cost 77 cents in 1985. I started collecting comics that year and I recall them being 75 with some titles still at 65 . So in adjusted figures, comic actually got cheaper over the years (albeit thinner too). Now, using the same tool, something that cost 75 cents in 1985 should cost $\$ 1.48$ in 2009. The cheapest comics today are $\$ 2.99$ - more than double what inflation would cause!
